2019 UNDERGRADUATE SUMMER FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION

Application Deadline: May 1, 2019
Please allow at least three weeks for processing

Summer Session Financial Aid is available in the form of work and loans for matriculated Cornell University undergraduate students based on eligibility available for the 2018-19 aid year. **Cornell-based grant aid is not available for summer enrollment. Bursar and Cornell Card balances must be paid in full to register for summer courses and before your aid application will be considered.**

The 2019 Summer Financial Aid Application is required for those enrolling in at least six credits. In order to be eligible for a Federal Pell Grant, students must have received a Pell Grant for the 2018 - 2019 Academic Year.

If you do not meet this criteria, you are not eligible for need-based aid or loans and you do **NOT** need to submit this application. If you are in need of funding, you can apply for a private student loan. By choosing to utilize a private loan, it is your responsibility to apply, with a cosigner, through an outside lender of your choice. If you need help finding a lender, please visit our website at <https://finaid.cornell.edu/types-aid/loans/alternative-loans-and-financing>. Once you have chosen the lender, you will complete their application process. **Please clearly specify the loan period as May-August.** After you complete the application, we will receive a notification from the lender to certify your approved loan based on your enrollment and summer cost of attendance. The lender will then send the funds directly to us to apply to your bursar account.

Please proceed with the application process if you are enrolling for at least six credits or need fewer than six credits to graduate in August 2019. Please be advised that we will not aid students for tuition costs over eight credits.

- If you are enrolling in an independent study, you must submit a copy of your completed Application for Independent Study. You need to submit the original to the School of Continuing Education and Summer Sessions when you register. The Application for Independent Study is available at the School of Continuing Education and Summer Sessions, B20 Day Hall, or on their website.
- Written permission from your college registrar must be provided along with this application if:
 - You are currently on a leave of absence, but have permission to return for Summer Session.
 - You need the course(s) listed below to graduate in August 2019. Please have your registrar specify the course(s) and corresponding number of credits required for you to graduate in August 2019.
 - Your summer enrollment exceeds Summer Session's recommended course load as specified on page two of this application.
- Please note that in order to receive a federal or Cornell University (Gardner/Shoemaker) loan for the first time, the electronic Master Promissory Note must be signed and online Entrance Counseling be completed. Please review your Student Center To Do List for requirements.

Summer Session Withdrawal Policy

Summer Session financial aid is reviewed based on the enrollment information provided on your 2019 Summer Session Financial Aid Application. Any change to your enrollment, courses or credit hours, may affect your aid. **Students are required to take at least 6 credits at all times in order to maintain summer financial aid. Students are required to notify the Office of Financial Aid and Student Employment in writing of any changes made to summer enrollment. Failure to provide notification of enrollment changes may result in a balance owed on your Bursar account. Aid will be adjusted if enrollment is changed, making the student responsible for the payment of all late withdrawal fees.**
